GENERAL RULES

• All games are carried with JKA Match Rule and Judge Regulation.

• Kata must be JKA standardization.

before entering Shiai jo to the direction of the Shushin, • Bow (Rei) in Kata shiai:

then bow to each other on the enbu-sen, then musubi-dachi

after match rei each other on the enbu-sen then after leaving of Shiai jo again rei.

bow before entering Shiai jo and on the enbu-sen bow each other • Bow (Rei) in Kumite shiai:

(respect each other). It is not necessary bow to the referee.

• Hansoku: Kumite – after 2 wins by hansoku-gachi must competitor stop competing, and cannot participate in kumite team.

• Only one official registered manager by country or club can raise protests against the judge's decisions.

- Each club can register 1 kata team in each age category and 1 kumite team boys and 1 kumite team girls, 1 manager and up to 6 coaches.
- Every competitor must wear a white karate gi with name or emblem of country or club he represents on the left chest, without any other advertisement or badge. All the contestants should bring by themselves Kumite equipment which is obligated to wear.
- Every competitor must wear an identification number (which will be assigned after the registration and tournament's organization) on his/her back.
- No change of contestants after the registration is admitted.
- Definition of age: The age of the contestants for each division is considered as that reached by the first day of Czech JKA Championship

tournament (Please note that the decisive date 7th November 2020!!!)

• Disqualification: Any contestant who was ordered to stop from the match by the officially appointed tournament doctor will be disqualified

and unable to continue. The doctor holds the decision.

- Each contestant must carry health insurance and is responsible for his/her own healthcare beyond that which is available by the tournament doctors.
- Please be noted that foul in the junior Kumite match is very strict than adult's case.
- Every contestant must sign the Consent Form. Nonfulfillment of this procedure will cause the disqualification of the contestant from participation in the tournament. The manager of each country is responsible for submitting the forms of all participants from one's own country prior to the tournament.
- Each club can register judges for tournament, rest of the judges will be completed by organizer. Only referees with a JKA Europe or JKA World Federation license will be accepted.



• Competition system:

<Kata>

Red and white tournament style, flag system from first round to final (to best 4).

Final best 4, point system,

*In case of tie, the relevant contestant must engage in an extra match (Sai-shiai) both in red and white tournament and point system – same kata.

<Kumite>

Jiyu Kumite (Free Sparring) from first round to the final. Elimination and semifinals Shobu Ippon - the One Point System (2 minutes). Final match Shobu Sanbon (all categories except juniors 2 minutes, junior categories 3 minutes).

* In case of tie in elimination, the relevant contestant must engage in an extra match Sai-sai-shiai (Sakidoru shobu, 1 minute)

* In case of tie in semifinal or final matches, the relevant contestant must engage in an extra match Sai-shiai (1 minute), and in case of hikiwake will be applied Sai-sai-shiai (Sakidoru shobu, 1 minute)

Gloves, mouthpiece for every contestant are required

Chest protector - a) for girls of all age categories is required.

- b) for all until the age of 15 included is required

(Gloves and chest protector are required to be JKA official ones)

<Kata team>

3 men/3 women. Each club can register one team men and women in each age category.

Elimination (to best 4), point system,

Final best 4, point system,

*In case of tie, the relevant contestant must engage in an extra match (Sai-shiai) same kata in point system. Contestant must choose different KATA in final than in elimination or semifinal.

<Kumite team>

6 men/ 6women. Each club can register one team men and one team women. Team have to consist from one competitor in each age category with 1 substitute in each category (one competitor from category 7-9 years old (y. o.), one from 10-11 y. o., one from 12-13 y. o., one from 14-15 y. o., and one from 16-17 y. o. and one from 18-20 y. o.)

Jiyu Kumite (Free Sparring) from first round to the final, Shobu Ippon - the One Point System (2 minutes).

* In case of tie there will be announced hikiwake

* In case of final tie (even after applying the terms of ippon, wazari) the contestant from highest age category must engage in an extra match Sai-shiai (1 minute) and in hikiwake will be applied Sai-sai-shiai (Sakidoru shobu, 1 minute)
